### **FURTHER WORK ON THE CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

The most important project last year was the European curriculum development project organised by the Royal School of Library and Information Science in cooperation with EUCLID. Following up and elaborating upon that project will be our most important task in the immediate future:

It is the goal of the EUCLID board to broaden and deepen the discussions on the report. We foresee the following initiatives:

1. We believe that the document from the curriculum development project which can be accessed from EUCLID's website, represents a fruitful platform for seminar and discussions among LIS-professionals on a departmental, regional or national level. Within the levels of our capacity we in the EUCLID-board are more than happy to provide you with speakers at such seminars.
2. The EUCLID-session at the coming BOBCATSSS-conference in Prague will also focus upon European curriculum development.
3. The project will be concluded with a conference taking place in connection with EUCLID's next council, probably in August 2007.

### **BOBCATSSS 2007**

We take this opportunity to remind you of BOBCATSSS 2006 taking place in beautiful Prague. As mentioned in the paragraph above, EUCLID will have a session on the curriculum development project. We also hope that each one of you will stimulate students to participate and send in papers to the conference.

### **EUCLID-PRIZE FOR PROMOTING EUROPEAN COOPERATION IN LIS**

At its latest board meeting the EUCLID-board decided to establish a prize to be awarded to a person within the field of LIS who has done outstanding work to promote European cooperation within LIS education and/or research. The winner will be announced and the prize will be awarded in connection with the yearly BOBCATSSS-conferences. The EUCLID-board, which is the jury of the prize, welcomes proposals on potential candidates to be awarded with the prize for 2007.

## **COOPERATION WITH EBLIDA**

EUCLID's chairman gave a lecture on the European curriculum development project at an EBLIDA-meeting in Budapest in May. We will also be represented at meeting in EBLIDA's committee for professional qualifications in September this year.
